- Health Clinics

Health Clinics provide prenatal care, primary care, and other medical care; some clinics provide dental care. Sites accept most insurances. All locations can assist you in enrolling in eligible health insurance plans. Hours are generally weekdays and evenings, including some Saturdays. Always call to confirm hours and make an appointment. Where walk-in services are available they are first-come, first-served.

- Urgent Care

Urgent Care locations can treat a variety of illnesses and conditions that are not life threatening. Some locations are affiliated with local hospitals and health clinics. Most of these facilities see patients who have insurance, including Medicaid. Some can assist you in finding insurance coverage or other help paying for care.

You would go to Urgent Care because you are unable to get an appointment at a clinic or your doctor, the location is local to you, and has hours that meet your need.

To find these locations, do an online search for "urgent care near me" or "urgent care" and your zipcode. Alwaus call the location before you go to confirm your coverage and the hours.

Hospitals

In a life-threatening emergency, call 911 and go directly to the nearest hospital. Review the list of locations below or use a web browser to search for "Hospitals near me." Generally an ambulance will take you to the nearest hospital that can address your needs.

If you returned from a correctional facility with basic Medicaid, you have the necessary insurance coverage.

If you are not insured, you can still go to the hospital; they are required to treat you for care. The resulting bill will by your responsibility but you can inquire about charity care options and discounts. There may also be staff to help you apply for care.
